## What course duration is best for me?

You are able to book a course online at [www.advanced-driving.co.uk/book/](http://www.advanced-driving.co.uk/book/). Here is an insight into the course durations we offer:

### 1 x 3.5-hour session:

This is the shortest course we offer and is perfect for covering the key elements of driver training—such as advanced driving, building confidence, motorway skills, refresher training, or pre-court preparation.

For private clients, it's an excellent “toe-in-the-water” option: ideal if you'd like to try a single session before committing to further training, or if you feel that 3.5 hours will be sufficient to meet your needs.

#### Advantages:

- Lowest cost course
- Ideal if you're limited on time
- Great if you only need the key elements/ essentials covered

#### Disadvantages:

- It won't help as much with more ingrained issues
- Cost per 3.5hr it's the most expensive
- You would lose out on the cost savings if you decided to book more sessions

### 1 x 7-hour session:

This course is ideal for those who need more than a single 3.5-hour session and prefer to complete their training in one full day. The course runs for 7 hours in total, including two 30-minute rest breaks. While it can be a demanding day, the extended time allows us to cover a great deal in depth.

Compared with the shorter 3.5-hour session, this course provides more opportunity to:

- Identify and correct ingrained bad habits
- Introduce and practise advanced and defensive driving techniques in greater detail
- Produce a more comprehensive and detailed driving report

It is the preferred format for pre-court advanced driver training, particularly in cases where a driving ban may be likely or for motorway training where a client lives a long distance from a motorway.

#### Advantages:

- Cheaper than 2 x 3.5hr sessions
- Ideal if time is an issue
- Ideal if you prefer an intensive approach

#### Disadvantages:

- Can be tiring for some drivers
- Compared to the 2 x 3.5 hours, there is no time to reflect and absorb on the first session
- It won't help as much as longer courses for more deeply ingrained issues

## 2 x 3.5hr sessions:

This is more suited to clients who want more than the 1 x 3.5-hour session, and don't want to do 7 hours in one session. The time in between the first and second session is valuable, as it gives you time to reflect and absorb what has been taught. With this course, the second session is often where a lot of things fall into place. Many clients who book a single 3.5-hour session often return and take a final 3.5-hour session.

### Advantages:

- A good cost vs duration compromise
- Ideal if you want longer than 3.5-hour but don't want a single 7-hour session
- Time in between works really well for a lot of drivers

### Disadvantages:

- It won't help quite as much for more ingrained issues
- The cost per 3.5-hour session it's not as cheap as the longer duration courses
- It costs more than a 1 x 7hr session

## Longer Duration Courses:

We offer three longer-duration courses:

**3 x 3.5hr session. Ideal for moderate driving issues**

**4 x 3.5hr session. Ideal for moderate to significant driving issues**

**5 x 3.5hr session. Ideal for those with significant issues**

Our 3, 4, or 5 x 3.5-hour sessions are designed for drivers who face specific challenges, such as driving anxiety, difficulties on particular types of roads, or returning to driving after a long break. For those whose driving issues are significantly affecting their daily lives, we recommend these extended courses.

They provide the time needed not only to identify the root causes of your challenges, but also to work through them at a manageable pace. Unlike shorter courses, these sessions allow us to build your skills and confidence gradually and effectively.

The breaks between each session are equally valuable, giving you time to reflect, absorb what you've learned, and practise new techniques before moving forward.

Longer courses not only provide greater value, with a reduced cost per session, but also allow more time with your tutor to identify and address issues in depth. This extended approach gives you the opportunity to practise, reinforce, and embed new skills, many of which you may never have been aware of without this training.
